



Dr Prem K Motwani Professor, Jawaharlal Nehru University

Prof. Prem Motwani was Professor of Japanese Studies (Retired) Independent Consultant on TPM/TQM audit preparation/health check.

He has published “Becoming World Class-Lessons from Made-in Japan” in 2021. He was awarded the order of the Rising Sun, Gold Rays with Neck Ribbons by the Japanese Government in Autumn 2020, in recognition of his contribution to promoting academic exchange and mutual understanding between Japan and India.
